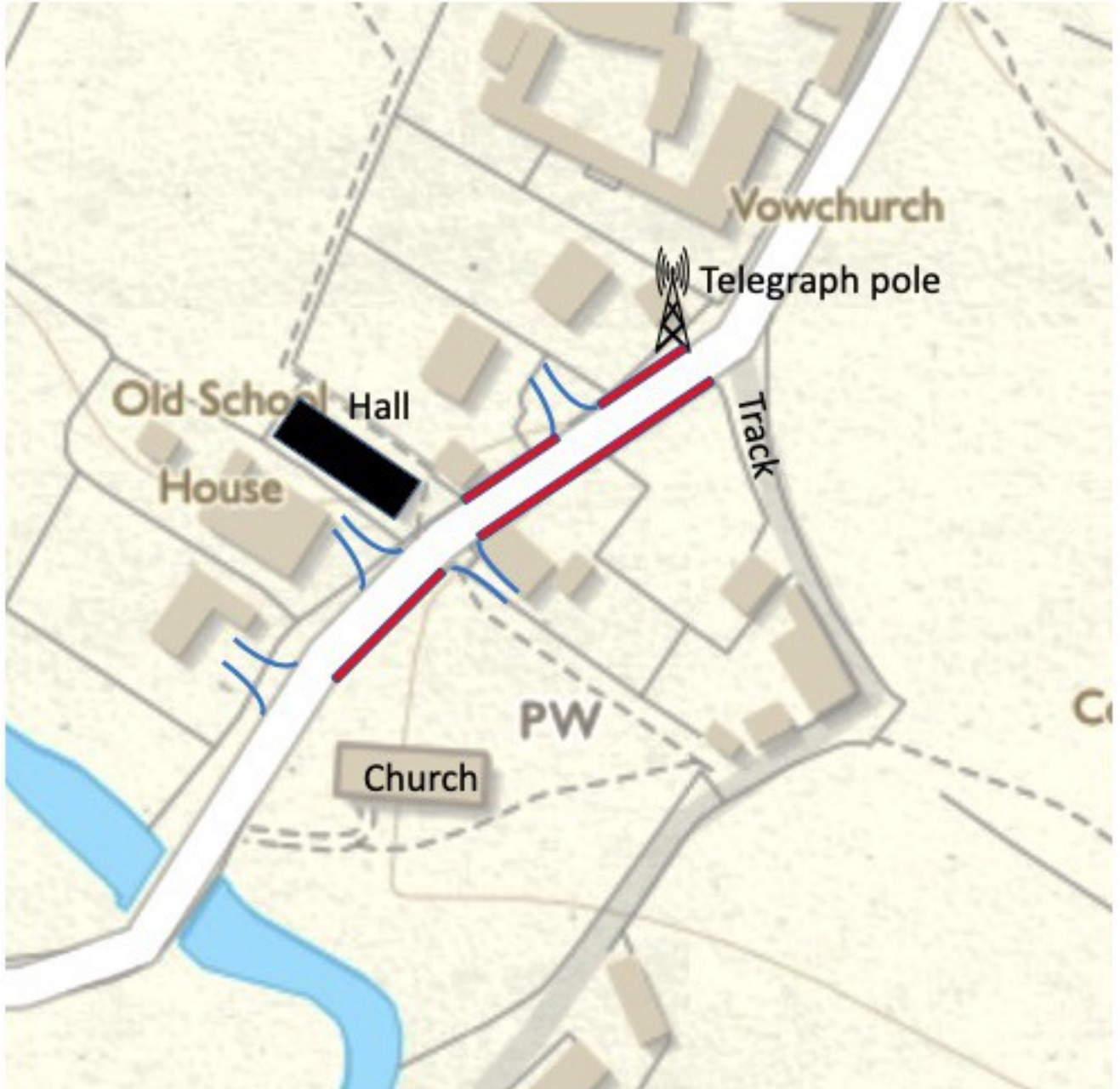


TRAFFIC CONE PLAN

TRAFFIC CONE PLAN

Parking is restricted at the hall and this is exacerbated where the road narrows. Parking in this narrow area should be avoided as it greatly restricts the ability of large farm vehicles, which regularly use the road, to pass unhindered and greatly increases the chances of damage to cars. Additionally, in the area down towards the church, parking should be restricted to one side of the road only.

No waiting cones are provided (stored outside to the side of the hall) and they should be placed, at suitable intervals, as follows:

- On the near side of the road between the hall property boundary and the telegraph pole just before the left bend. (Do not obstruct the driveways shown in blue).
- The corresponding section of road on the opposite side of the road between the driveway to Bower Oak Cottage and the track.
- Alongside the wall of the churchyard towards the church entrance.

The plan showing where cones should be placed is shown overleaf.

Please ensure all cones are returned to the side of the hall immediately after the event.
